1. AGM RESOLUTIONS

THE FOLLOWING ARE RESOLUTIONS TAKEN BY PARENTS AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD ON THE 4TH NOVEMBER 2017 AT PRINCESS PRIMARY SCHOOL.

- Parents reaffirm their commitment to supporting the school throughout their children schooling years at Princess Primary
- Parents resolved that the Upkeep and maintenance of the school is sacrosanct. Therefore, as parents, we will be actively involved in all manner of fundraising the school will embark on to ensure that the quality and standards of education at Princess Primary do not drop.
- Parents commit to support the teachers and strengthen parent teacher relationship. All matters of concern will be raised with the class teacher first, then escalate to principal if not satisfied with the response by the teacher. Parents will endeavour to resolve all matters with the teacher.
- All pending school projects should be undertaken as per SGB recommendations: basketball court, Volleyball Court, Procurement of Generator to power the school, Roofing the Garage, Feeding Scheme Shelter, Building 8 Additional Classrooms, Princess Arena. These are subject to available funds and in order of priority.
- Learner Discipline starts at home. Parents will assist the school in ensuring that their children are well mannered at all times and display high level of respect towards others.
- All new Learners and their parents will attend a compulsory full day orientation and induction workshop. Parents must attend together with their children.

- All existing Learners and Parents will attend a compulsory full day school policy mediation workshop. Parents must attend together with their children.
- School Fees shall increase by **5%** for the academic year 2018. The school fees payable for the year 2018 is **R 7455.00**
- All outstanding school fees for the year 2017 **MUST** be settled on or before 31 December 2017. This is the final extension as per request and agreement by parents at the AGM. All outstanding school fees will be handed over for collection with effect from the 1st of January 2018. **NO NEGOTIATIONS WILL BE ENTERED INTO.**
- **SCHOOL FEES PAYMENT STRUCTURE AND DISCOUNTS APPLICABLE FOR 2018**
 - Full School Fees payment on or before End of January 2018: **10%** . Fees payable: **R 6710.00** (discount amount is **R745**)
 - Full School Fees payment on or before End of February 2018: **7.5%** Fees payable: **R 6895.90** (discount amount is **R 559.10**)
 - Full School Fees payment on or before End of March 2018: **5%** Fees payable: **R 7082.25** (discount amount is **R372.75**)
 - **NB: FOR THE SCHOOL TO OPERATE OPTIMALLY IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2108, ALL PARENTS RESOLVED TO PAY AN AMOUNT OF R 2000.00 AS PART PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEES ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL IN 2018. (17 JANUARY 2018)**
